In short, there's a lot of exciting changes happening in education right now. Let's embrace these changes and work together to create a better future. Stay curious and keep learning!

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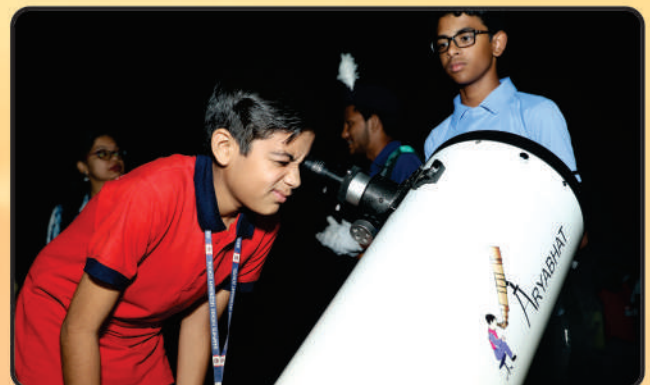
